As president, Mr. Godfrey has been responsible for the development of EFI's interdisciplinary education program. Before being elected president of EFI, Mr. Godfrey was an architect. His work included the master planning of new cities in Saudi Arabia and China as well as less ambitious projects in the United States, the Middle East, and Pacific Basin.

Mr. Godfrey is a founder of the United States Partnership for Education for Sustainable Development and holds degrees in Government, Architecture and Environmental Science from the University of Notre Dame.
