

## EXPLANATORY NOTES ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE AAU BYE-LAWS

1. The name of the 'Executive Board' has been changed everywhere to 'Governing Board' – see Explanatory Notes to Amendments to AAU Constitution.
2. Bye-Law 3 (1): The countries in each region now appear in an annex to the Bye-Laws, rather than the Constitution.
3. Bye-Laws 7 and 8: The bulk of the amendments occur in these two Bye-Laws but, in essence, there is no fundamental change to what already exists. The various sections have just been tidied up and the clauses arranged in a more logical sequence. The important clauses (7) and (8) of Bye-Law 8 have been transferred to the Constitution.
4. Bye-Law 14: An amendment is proposed in the Constitution whereby there is only a First Vice-President, designated by the Governing Board (rather than having a First, Second and Third Vice-President according to votes obtained), and the change made here reflects the Constitutional amendment.
5. Bye-Law 17: This is superfluous and is fully covered by Bye-Law 18 (now 17).
